To the Trustees of the Japanese American Budokan Trust,

I want to express my gratitude for your support of our trust. During 2025, the contributions made to the trust were able to fund our athletes and support their academic and athletic pursuits.

The recipients of the Reiko Makino Scholarship, Colin Chou and Justin Katayama, were both granted \$2,500 in scholarship funds for the 2025–2026 school year. Both Colin and Justin are exemplary members of our community and upstanding students, and I am grateful that our trust was able to aid them in their journey into higher education.

As for the JABT Athletic Grant, we ended up having no applicants last year. We expect that there will be more applicants this year, as many of our members have started to compete regularly, both locally and internationally.

To give a summary of the financial activities from 2025:

- \$15,000 was contributed to the trust, thanks to our donors, Yoko Makino, Siri Willoch, and Miki House Americas, Inc.
- \$5,000 was given to the recipients of the Reiko Makino Scholarship.
- \$45 was spent on fees.

This leaves the current balance of the trust at \$9,955. With your continued support, we hope to fund a greater number of athletes this year through both the Reiko Makino Scholarship and the JABT Athletic Grant. We're grateful for the ongoing generosity and support that makes these scholarships possible.
